



## \*\*Pharmacy Provider Notice #300 –Makena Market Withdrawal\*\*

## April 10th, 2023

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration made the following announcement regarding the drug Makena on Thursday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023:

"Today, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration announced the final decision to withdraw approval of Makena—a drug that had been approved under the accelerated approval pathway. This drug was approved to reduce the risk of preterm birth in women pregnant with one baby who have a history of spontaneous preterm birth. The decision was issued jointly by the FDA Commissioner and Chief Scientist. Effective today, Makena and its generics are no longer approved and cannot lawfully be distributed in interstate commerce."

In accordance with this decision, the Kentucky Department for Medicaid Services will no longer approve new requests for Makena or its generics. DMS will permit those currently taking the medication to continue therapy with prescriber approval and as supply permits.

Thank you for helping Kentucky Medicaid members maintain access to cost effective medications by selecting drugs on the preferred drug list whenever possible.
